

Career Management Center hosts 3rd annual Freeman Energy Expo

Students from the Freeman School's New Orleans campus traveled to Houston on Friday (Sept. 9) for a day of information sessions, seminars and one-on-one networking with professionals in the energy field.

The occasion was the Freeman Energy Expo, an annual event organized by the Freeman School's Career Management Center (CMC) that gives students pursuing careers in energy the opportunity to connect with recruiters, alumni and employees who support hiring initiatives within their organizations. This year's expo was sponsored by Phillips 66 and featured a keynote presentation from Jane Gasdaska, general manager, US Product Supply & Distribution, for Phillips 66 Commercial, who
