

WWL-TV: Professor: Rare for Anyone to be on Shallow Water Platforms

[Eric Smith](#), associate director of the Tulane Energy Institute and professor of practice at the A. B. Freeman School of Business, spoke with WWL-TV's Lauren Gale about oil and gas production in Lake Pontchartrain in the wake of Sunday night's explosion and fire aboard a platform.

"You don't see permanent crews unless you're pretty far off shore in deep water," Smith said.

He thinks because a crew was out on the platform they were doing maintenance on the equipment.

"What I suspect happened is you have a contract crew out there doing maintenance and someone cut into the wrong pipe," Smith said.
