Biz New Orleans: Venture Capital University comes to New Orleans

<u>Biz New Orleans</u> interviewed <u>Rob Lalka</u>, executive director of the Freeman School's <u>Lepage Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation</u>, about <u>VC University Live</u>, the upcoming executive education program co-presented by the Freeman School, UC Berkeley School of Law's Startup@BerkeleyLaw initiative and the National Venture Capital Association. In addition to providing details on speakers and the program, which will take place Sept. 19-21 at the Stewart Center CBD, Lalka discussed the importance of growing the VC ecosystem in the South, which accounts for just 14% of U.S. total capital investments.

"When I started this job nearly two years ago, I felt that there was a whole lot of sizzle around entrepreneurship in New Orleans," said Lalka. "But if you look at the stats, you can see that we've got a lot more work to do."
