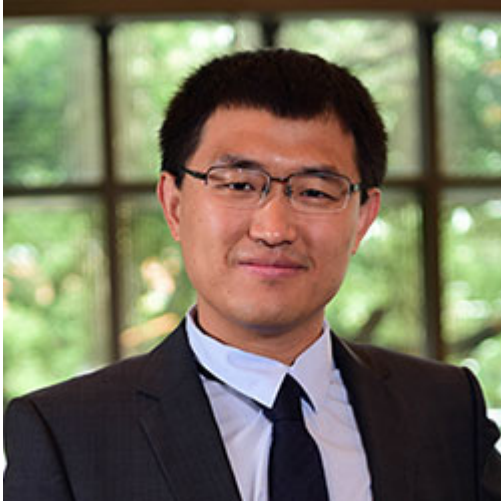


## Research Notes: Han Jiang
