Dear members of the Freeman School community:

For a little over nine years now, I have had the privilege of serving as the dean of the A. B. Freeman School of Business. Now, as the final year of my second five-year term as dean is progressing, I have been doing a lot of thinking about my future and what is best for the Freeman School. I have consulted a variety of people, most importantly my family and friends, and have reflected at length on the implications of the context created by the COVID-19 pandemic. I also have engaged with the Freeman School's Business School Council (BSC) and the campus leadership about the future of the Freeman School.
