Poets&Quants: As Covid Keeps Students Out Of US, Tulane Launches Unique Partnership In China

Dean Ira Solomon was interviewed by Poets & Quants for a story highlighting the Freeman School's agreement with Peking University in Beijing to offer Chinese students admitted to Freeman graduate programs "visiting student" status at the university's Guanghua School of Management, where they could attend in-person classes structured around Tulane syllabi.
