A noted scholar with decades of important research focused on human resource issues related to disabilities in the workplace, Colella has published in prestigious journals in both management and psychology and has received numerous citations. In addition to her scholarly activity related to EDI, Colella served as chairperson of the Freeman School's task on EDI as part of the school's strategic planning process.
