Freeman School Dean Paulo Goes has been appointed to the Board of Directors of [AACSB International](#). The one-year appointment was effective July 1.

Goes was named dean of the Freeman School in 2021 after serving five years as dean of the Eller College of Management at the University of Arizona, where he built nationally recognized interdisciplinary programs in entrepreneurship and innovation,

digital transformation, economics and business while prioritizing diversity, equity and inclusion initiatives. During his tenure, Goes implemented a new strategic plan and oversaw dramatic growth in the college's online graduate programs in management information systems, cybersecurity, healthcare management and accounting. Prior to becoming dean, Goes served as the Salter Distinguished Professor of Management and Technology and head of the University of Arizona's nationally ranked Department of Management Information Systems (MIS).
