Wall Street's never done this well. In fact, you could argue this is the best economy in six decades, but Main Street is still struggling. If you're a small business, you can't find labor. Your costs are going up. It seems like you're not going to be able to pass it on to consumers like you did in the beginning of this inflation. So that's what they're seeing and that's what

they're feeling. It's going to be interesting to see how this shake out because it doesn't seem much different than the political horizon itself, where 50% of the people think the economy is terrible and then 50% really see this.
