"When looking at the investments in cities like Boston, New York and San Francisco, New Orleans entrepreneurs receive significantly less venture capital," said Rob Lalka, director of the Albert Lepage Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation at Tulane University. "But even

compared to other 'Rise of the Rest' cities like Nashville, Raleigh-Durham, Salt Lake City, and Denver-Boulder, there's still a significant gap. The data show we still have work to do."
