

The Current: Will Lake Charles area refineries benefit from Trump's Venezuela takeover?

[Eric Smith](#), professor of practice and associate director of the Tulane Energy Institute, was interviewed by [The Current](#) about the potential impact of President Trump's takeover of Venezuela on Louisiana's refining industry.

“We’re bringing in today about 200,000 barrels a day, maybe a little more, from Venezuela, largely because of the Chevron presence,” Smith says.
“That’s kind of a drop in the bucket. It’s enough to, you know, probably support two or three of our refineries, but we’ve got 15 just in Louisiana.”
